OCSD Bond Ballot Advisory – *Connecting School Facilities to Community Vision*

A PROPOSAL TO TESTING LRFAC RECOMMENDATIONS & BUILD COMMUNITY VISION

Elementary Work Session (one evening session at each school during October)

Goal is to answer: What needs to be done at each site to address safety and security, to create warm and welcoming entries, and to address critical issues and deficiencies?

Understand that this is phase one of a multiple phase master plan initiative.

Attendance should reflect a goal to build a broad-based understanding and support and should include representation from staff, community, and business partnerships including those that contribute to recreational sports and activities.

Presentation will include background of work-to-date and a sketch phase one master plan solution for each facility. DOWA-IBI will ask participants to envision current conditions and arrival experience and to contrast this current experience with what ought to be relative to safety and security and the creation of warm and welcoming entries.

DOWA-IBI follow up will include plan development and cost analysis to determine what portion of the bond proceeds will need to be allocated to addressing issues at each elementary facility.

Middle School Work Sessions (two evening sessions at each school during November)

Attendance should reflect a goal to build a broad-based understanding and support and should include representation from staff, community, and business partnerships including those that contribute to recreational sports and activities.

Goal is to answer: What might our plan to substantially renovate each Middle School mean specifically at each site?

Invite participants to share issues relative to current conditions and deficiencies.

Presentation will include communication of the educational vision resulting from ED Spec Committee work.
